

Republic of A1 – Administrative Arrangements Order

I, Sir. Philip Fish, Chairman of the Most Glorious People's Republic of A1 revoke all administrative arrangements previously ordered and order that:

1. The matters dealt with by a Ministry of State include:
 - (a) The matters referred to in the Part of the Schedule relating to that Ministry; and
 - (b) Matters arising under the legislation administered by a Minister of State administering the Ministry.

2. The legislation administered by a Minister of State administering a Ministry is:
 - (a) The legislation referred to in the Part of the Schedule relating to that Ministry; and
 - (b) Legislation passed before or after the date of this Order, which relates to a matter dealt with by the Ministry, not being legislation referred to in another Part of the Schedule.
