
'CAULFISH CONVENTION' OFFICIAL JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ

19TH APRIL 2010

1. We, the delegations from the Most Glorious People's Republic of A1 and the Federal State of A1, met in Ppirtville from the 8th April to the 19th April.
2. We were tasked by our respective governments and peoples to bring a cease-fire into place in the current conflict that has come to be known as the 'Great Patriotic War', or the 'A1 Civil War'.
3. We have therefore today pledged to enact this cease-fire between our respective nations under the following conditions:
 - a. That both sides recognise the territorial claims as of 1159 EST 19th April 2010 of the other and that these claims be frozen upon the signing of this document
 - b. That all forces on both sides are to be demobilised within the next three days
 - c. That respective diplomatic representation and recognition be established within the next two weeks
 - d. That a cease-fire, applying to all forces of both parties, be put into force effective as of 0001 20th April 2010
4. We, remaining cognisant of the issues raised in this communiqué, hereby pledge ourselves to the contents of this document.
